A PROGRAM TO TRAIN YOUTHS AGES 9-12 TO BE WESTON ART GALLERY DOCENTS

The Cincinnati Arts Association's Alice F. and Harris K. Weston Art Gallery announces the sixteenth season of its acclaimed art ambassadorial program, *Docentitos*. The two-week summer camp is for children between the ages of 9 and 12 and takes place in the Weston Art Gallery in the Aronoff Center for the Arts. Daily activities include classes, artist talks, theater tours, workshops, installation and studio visits, script rehearsals, field trips and a final project. The 2012 summer session will explore:

Built in the Digital World

A group exhibition of artists whose work originates in the computer realm through the use of 3-D imaging and other software programming, *Built in the Digital World* features painting, prints,

sculpture and video. Participating artists include James Duesing (Pittsburgh, PA), Kimberly Burleigh, McCrystle Wood and Derrick Woodham (all Cincinnati, OH).

- ▶ Age 9-12
- ▶ Interest in the arts with a willingness to learn and explore
- ▶ Strong communication skills
- ▶ Willing to collaborate with other *Docentitos* to develop a presentation and final project
- ▶ Willing to commit to an orientation and two-week training session
- ▶ Available to conduct tours on opening night June 15, 6-9pm, and throughout the exhibition as scheduled (June 15-August 31, 2012)
- ▶ Black dress pants/skirt and shoes for uniform

Commitment of Parents:

- ▶ Support their child's experience in the program and encourage him or her in exploration of the exhibition
- ▶ Transport their child to and from the Aronoff Center for the Arts on training and tour dates, including arriving and picking up their child in a timely manner
- ▶ Attend the orientation session with their child on June 1 to familiarize him or her with the nature of the artists' work and the program goals
- ▶ \$25 supply fee payable at orientation
